SAFEGUARDING

This half day course supports learners in developing knowledge, skills and understanding about the importance of responsibilities for Safeguarding Adults with care and support needs.

The course delivers information on the relevant safeguarding legislation, and the importance of safeguarding training for everyone that works with adults at risk.

Learners will understand the safeguarding policies and processes, and how to respond to, report and record any concerns, as well as what happens after a referral is made and the common barriers that can prevent those involved from speaking out.

Finally, you will learn about what happens once the Local Authority's adult safeguarding team have received the referral, the various stages that follow and some of the potential outcomes of the enquiry process.
